

PROVISION OF ZEBRA CROSSING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes to install a zebra pedestrian crossing across Greythorn Drive, West Bridgford in the Borough of Rushcliffe approximately 18 metres south of its junction with Walcote Drive


The crossing will incorporate a controlled area, on the existing raised plateau, indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where parking and loading will be prohibited. The extents of the controlled area are:-

GREYTHORN DRIVE, WEST BRIDGFORD (the east side)

• from its junction with Walcote Drive in a southerly direction for 42 metres

GREYTHORN DRIVE, WEST BRIDGFORD (the west side)

• from its junction with Walcote Drive in a southerly direction for 33 metres
