

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Hartland Drive, Seaton Way, Shaldon Close and Spring Lane, Mapperley)(Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2021 (7236)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in Mapperley in the Borough of Gedling:-

Proposed **No waiting at any time** restrictions (double yellow lines) at the following location:-

- HARTLAND DRIVE (the north side)
 - from its junction with Spring Lane in a southerly and then a westerly direction for 88 metres.
- 2. HARTLAND DRIVE (the south side)
- (i) from its junction with Spring Lane in a southerly and then a westerly direction for 52 metres.
- (ii) from a point 72 metres south and west of its junction with Spring Lane in a westerly and then a southerly direction to a point opposite the southern kerb line of Sidbury Close.
- 3. SEATON WAY (the north side)
 - from a point 129 metres south-east of a point opposite the south-eastern kerbline of Instow Close in a south-easterly and then a north-easterly direction for a distance of 26 metres.
- 4. <u>SEATON WAY(the north-east side)</u>
 - from its junction with Shaldon Close in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 20 metres.
- 5. SEATON WAY (the south-east side)
 - from a point 118 metres south-east of its junction with Instow Close in a south-easterly and then a north-easterly direction to a point 65 metres east of its junction with Hartland Drive.
- 6. <u>SEATON WAY (the south-west side)</u>
 - from a point 49 metres east of a point opposite the eastern kerb line of Hartland Drive in a southeasterly and then a south-westerly direction for a distance of 27 metres.
- 7. SHALDON CLOSE (the south-east side)
 - from its junction with Seaton Way in a north-easterly and then a north-westerly direction to its north-western extremity (outside 14 Shaldon Close).
- 8. SPRING LANE (the south side)
 - from a point 10 metres west of its junction with Hartland Drive in an easterly direction to a point 25 metres east of the same junction.

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such at County Hall and libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.

The proposed restrictions are intended to remove parked vehicles from the bends and near the pedestrian entrances into the Gedling Country Park on Hartland Drive, Seaton Way and Shaldon Close. The intention is to allow for the safe passage of vehicles.
