

## THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A620 BABWORTH ROAD AND STRAIGHT MILE, RETFORD) (40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2020(1236)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council **HAS MADE** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Retford in the District of Bassetlaw: -

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the following length of road: -

## A620 Babworth Road, Retford

From a point 490 metres west of the centre line of its junction with Ordsall Road in a westerly direction to the centre line of its junction with B6420 Mansfield Road for 327 metres approximately.

## A620 Straight Mile, Retford

From the centre line of its junction with B6420 Mansfield Road in a westerly direction to a point of 218 metres west of that junction.

- 2. The following Orders are hereby revoked in so far as they relate to the lengths of road specified in the Schedules to this Order: -
  - The Nottinghamshire County Council (A620 Babworth Road, East Retford, Babworth and Worksop) (50MPH Speed Limit) Order 2004 (1068)
- Any previous speed limit order made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or any enactment replace by that Act in so far as it related to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order is hereby revoked.

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such at County Hall libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.
