

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Great Central Road and Deakins Court, Mansfield) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2019 (2222)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **HAS MADE** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Mansfield in the District of Mansfield:-

Vehicles will be prohibited from **waiting at any time** along the following lengths of road:

GREAT CENTRAL ROAD, MANSFIELD (the south-east side)

- from a point 62 metres north-east of its junction with Littleworth in a north-easterly direction for 108 metres

DEAKINS COURT, MANSFIELD (both sides)

- from its junction with Great Central Road in a north-westerly direction for 10 metres

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such as County Hall libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.
