**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council **HAS MADE** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Rainworth in the District of Newark and Sherwood: -

**KIRKLINGTON ROAD, RAINWORTH** (south side)

**PARKING BAYS.** Disabled Badge Holders

- from a point 110 metres east of its junction with Python Hill Road in an easterly direction for 12 metres
