

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Oakleaf Close, Mansfield) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2021 (2235)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Mansfield in the District of Mansfield: -

Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along the following lengths of road: -

Oakleaf Close (Mansfield) (north-east side)

• from its junction with Sherwood Avenue in a south easterly direction for 220 metres to its south-eastern extremity.

Oakleaf Close (Mansfield) (south-west side)

- from its junction with Sherwood avenue in a south easterly direction for 60 metres.
- from a point 113 metres south-east of its junction with Sherwood Avenue in a south-easterly direction for 107 metres to its south-eastern extremity.

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such at County Hall libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.
