

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Jubilee Street and Lime Grove, Newark) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2021 (3315)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **HAS MADE** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Newark in the District of Newark and Sherwood: -

Vehicles will be prohibited from Waiting At Any Time along the following length of road: -

<u>Lime Grove</u>, <u>Newark</u> (the south-east side)

• from a point 11 metres north-east of its junction with Jubilee Street in a south-westerly direction to a point 11 metres south-west of that junction.

Jubilee Street, Newark (both sides)

• from its junction with Lime Grove in a south-easterly direction for 10 metres.

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such at County Hall libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.
