

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Ashby Road, A60 Loughborough Road and Main Street, Rempstone) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2020 (8293)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **HAS MADE** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads in Rempstone in the Borough of Rushcliffe: -

Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along the following lengths of road: -

A60 LOUGHBOROUGH ROAD, REMPSTONE (the north-west side)

• from a point 7 metres south-west of its junction with Ashby Road to a point 12 metres north-east of that junction.

A60 LOUGHBOROUGH ROAD, REMPSTONE (the south-east side)

from a point 7 metres south-west of its junction with Main Street in a north-easterly direction to a
point 20 metres north-east of that junction.

ASHBY ROAD, REMPSTONE (the north-east side)

from its junction with A60 Loughborough Road in a north-westerly direction for 15 metres.

ASHBY ROAD, REMPSTONE (the south-west side)

• from its junction with A60 Loughborough Road in a north-westerly direction for 20 metres.

MAIN STREET, REMPSTONE (the north-east side)

• from its junction with A60 Loughborough Road in a south-easterly then north-easterly direction to a point 17 metres south-west of the south-west kerb line of Elms Close.

MAIN STREET, REMPSTONE (the south-west side)

• from its junction with (A60) Loughborough Road in a south-easterly then north-easterly direction to a point 13 metres south-west of the south-west kerb line of Elms Close.

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such at County Hall libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.
