ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Hoveringham and Caythorpe Area) (Weight Restriction) Traffic Regulation Order 2020 (3300)

The NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(4) and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and with the consent of the Secretary of State under Part II of Schedule 9 and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of that Schedule to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order, no heavy commercial vehicle shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform, to proceed in any of the roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall make it unlawful for a heavy commercial vehicle to proceed in the roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order if the vehicle is being used: -
 - (1) for or in connection with the conveyance of goods to or from premises situated on or adjacent to that length of road;
 - (2) for the purpose of agriculture on any land adjacent to that length of road or for or in connection with the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon such land;
 - (3) in connection with the carrying out on, or on the premises situated on or adjacent to, that length of road of any of the following operations, namely—
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of obstructions to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road;
 - (iv) the laying, erection or alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to the road, of any sewer or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of water, gas, electricity or any telegraphic line as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;

- (v) for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
- (vi) to proceed from any premises which are situated on or adjacent to that length of road and at which the vehicle is to be, or has been garaged, serviced or repaired;
- (vii) in the service of local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (viii) in connection with a circus, fair or similar event, the holding of which on, or in the vicinity of, that length of road has been authorised by the Council;
- (ix) on that road for or in connection with the conveyance of goods for sale from the vehicle;
- (x) to gain access to land or premises, which access is obtained only by proceeding along the length of road referred to in the said Article 1.

3. The Council are satisfied that for preserving or improving amenities by restricting the use on the roads referred to in Article 1 of this Order, of goods vehicles, it is requisite that Section 3(1) of the Act should not apply in relation to this Order.

4. In this Order "heavy commercial vehicle" has the same meaning as that ascribed to it in Section 138 of the Act.

5. This Order shall come into force for all purposes on the **20th day of November 2020** and may be cited as "The Nottinghamshire County Council (Hoveringham and Caythorpe Area) (Weight Restriction) Traffic Regulation Order 2020 (3300)"

6. The following Order is to be revoked in part:

"The Nottinghamshire County Council (Weight Restrictions) (No.1) Traffic Regulation Order 1982"

Schedule

Area of the Parishes of Caythorpe, Gonalston, Hoveringham and Lowdham in the District of Newark and Sherwood.

Part One

All lengths of roads within the area bounded by the following sections:

Section Description of boundary along section

A. The south-eastern highway boundary of Southwell Road and Nottingham Road

From roundabout junction A6097 and Southwell Road in a north-easterly direction to its interception of the Parish boundary between Gonalston and Thurgarton.

B. Parish Boundary between Gonalston and Thurgarton

From the south-east highway boundary of Nottingham Road in a south-easterly direction to the centre line of the Nottingham Newark Railway Line.

C. Parish Boundary between Hoveringham and Thurgarton

From the centre line of the Nottingham Newark railway line in a south-easterly direction to the south-western highway boundary of Thurgarton Lane, Thurgarton.

D. Western highway boundary of Thurgarton Lane, Thurgarton

From the parish boundary between Hoveringham and Thurgarton in a north-easterly direction to a point 155 metres south of Sailing Club Road.

E. Eastern highway boundary of Thurgarton Lane, Thurgarton

From a point 155 metres south of Sailing Club Road on the western side of Thurgarton Lane, Thurgarton, across the carriageway in an easterly direction, then in a southerly direction on the eastern side of Thurgarton Lane, Thurgarton to the parish boundary of Hoveringham and Thurgarton.

F. Parish boundary between Hoveringham and Thurgarton

From the north-eastern highway boundary of Thurgarton Lane, Thurgarton in a north-easterly direction to the parish boundary between Hoveringham and Bleasby.

G. Parish boundary between Hoveringham and Bleasby.

From the parish boundary between Hoveringham and Thurgarton in a south-easterly direction to the boundary between the borough of Rushcliffe and the District of Newark and Sherwood.

H. Boundary of the Borough of Rushcliffe and the District of Newark and Sherwood.

From the parish boundary between Hoveringham and Bleasby in a south-westerly direction to the parish boundary between Caythorpe and Gunthorpe.

I. Parish boundary between Gunthorpe and Caythorpe



From its boundary of the Borough of Rushcliffe and the District of Newark and Sherwood in a north-westerly direction to the parish boundary between Lowdham and Gunthorpe.

J. Parish boundary between Gunthorpe and Lowdham

From the parish boundary between Caythorpe and Gunthorpe in a south-westerly direction to the north-eastern highway boundary of the A6097

K. North-eastern highway boundary of A6097

From the parish boundary between Gunthorpe and Lowdham in a north-westerly direction to the roundabout junction with Southwell Road,
