

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Brick Kiln Lane and Winthorpe Street, Mansfield) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2021 (2242)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **HAS MADE** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Mansfield in the District of Mansfield: -

Vehicles will be prohibited from **waiting at any time** along the following lengths of road: -

Brick Kiln Lane (Mansfield) (south-west side)

- From a point 10 metres north-west of its junction with Winthorpe Street in a south-easterly direction to a point 8 metres south-east of that junction.

Winthorpe Street (Mansfield) (both sides)

- From its junction with Brick Kiln Lane in a south-westerly direction for 14 metres.
