

**The Nottinghamshire County Council (Selby Lane Area, Keyworth)  
(Revocation of Parking Restrictions) and (Prohibition of Waiting)  
Traffic Regulation Order 2021 (8311)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council **HAS MADE** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Keyworth in the Borough of Rushcliffe: -

- 1) To revoke the existing No Waiting Mon-Sat 8am-6pm restrictions at the following location: -

**Selby Lane, Keyworth** (the north side)

- from its junction with The Square in a north-easterly direction to a point 10 metres south-east of its junction with Elm Avenue.
- from a point 10 metres north-west of its junction with Windmill Court in a south-easterly direction to a point 10 metres south-east of that junction.

- 2) Vehicles will be prohibited from **Waiting At Any Time** along the following lengths of road:

**Elm Avenue, Keyworth** (both sides)

- from its junction with Selby Lane in a north-easterly direction for 11 metres.

**Selby Lane, Keyworth** (the north side)

- from its junction with The Square in a north-easterly direction to a point 10 metres south-east of its junction with Elm Avenue.
- from a point 10 metres north-west of its junction with Windmill Court in a south-easterly direction to a point 10 metres south-east of that junction.

**Windmill Court, Keyworth** (both sides)

- from its junction with Selby Lane in a north-easterly direction for 11 metres.

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such as County Hall libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.
