

PROVISION OF ZEBRA CROSSING – HICKINGS LANE, STAPLEFORD

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (Zebra crossing), proposes to install a zebra pedestrian crossing across Hickings Lane, Stapleford in the Borough of Broxtowe.

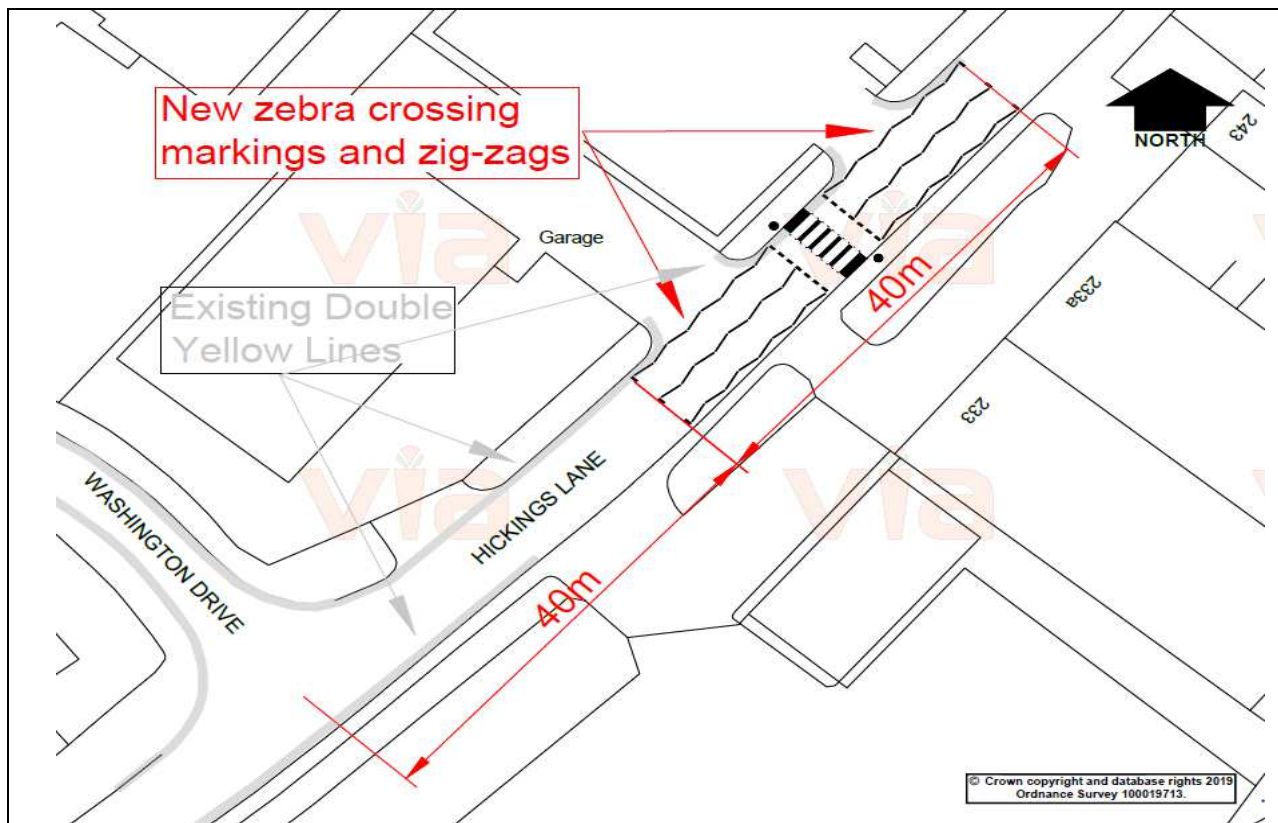
The crossing will incorporate a controlled area indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where parking and loading will be prohibited at all times. The extents of the controlled area are: -

HICKINGS LANE (north-west side)

- from a point approximately 40 metres north-east of its junction with Washington Drive in a north-easterly direction for 40 metres

HICKINGS LANE (south-east side)

- from a point approximately 40 metres north-east of its junction with Washington Drive in a north-easterly direction for 40 metres



The crossing is being installed to assist pedestrians crossing the road.
