**HIGH STREET AND MATTERSEY ROAD, EVERTON –
PROPOSED DOUBLE YELLOW LINES (NO WAITING AT ANY TIME) - (TRO1248)**

Via East Midlands Ltd, working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council, is proposing to introduce double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) restrictions on High Street and Mattersey Road, Everton. The restrictions are intended to keep the junctions with Gainsborough Road (A631) and the narrow length of High Street between its junction with Corner Farm Drive and Metcalfe Court, clear of parked vehicles. The removal of the parking from High Street will ensure that larger vehicles can travel along the road without being obstructed.

The parking restrictions will be marked with double yellow lines to the positions shown on the enclosed drawing.

Before proceeding further, I wish to consider the views of residents, businesses and organisations who may be interested in this matter. If your comments are in the form of an objection to the proposals and if they cannot be resolved, they will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time. Any observations on these proposals should reach me in writing, either by letter (address at bottom of letter) or email, by **14th February 2020**.
