

**The Nottinghamshire County Council (High Street and Mattersey Road,
Everton)(Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2020 (1248)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in Everton in the District of Bassetlaw:-

Proposed No waiting at any time restrictions (double yellow lines) at the following junctions:-

1. (i) HIGH STREET - (the east side)
from a point 56 metres north of its junction with Gainsborough Road (A631) in a northerly direction for a distance of 21 metres.
- (ii) HIGH STREET - (the west side)
from its junction with Gainsborough Road (A631) in a northerly direction for a distance of 17 metres.
- (iii) from a point 49 metres north of its junction with Gainsborough Road (A631) in a northerly direction for a distance of 38 metres.
- (iv) MATTERSEY ROAD - (both sides)
from its junction with Gainsborough Road (A631) in a southerly direction for a distance of 12 metres.

The double yellow lines are being introduced to remove parked vehicles from the junctions off Gainsborough Road (A631) and the narrow length of road between Corner Farm Drive and Metcalfe Court. The restrictions at the junctions will help ensure that the vehicles turning on or off Gainsborough Road are not obstructed by parked vehicles.
