<u>HIGH STREET, COLLINGHAM - PROPOSED ENFORCEABLE BUS STOP CLEARWAY - NO STOPPING AT ANY TIME, EXCEPT BUSES - PUBLIC ADVERT</u>

Via East Midlands Ltd, working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council, proposes to relocate and create a new enforceable bus stop clearway at the following stop, and as shown on the attached plan: -

No Stopping At Any Time, except buses - 19 metre clearway

• High Street, Collingham (NS0475)

Concerns have been raised about the accessibility of the bus stop for pedestrians, and buses being unable to properly use the stop due to parked vehicles. It is therefore proposed to install an enforceable bus stop clearway, which will prohibit other vehicles from parking or waiting in the bus stop at any time. This will be clearly identified with new road markings and signage. The main benefits of bus stop clearways are to:

- Help the bus align with the kerb to enable better access for disabled passengers and pushchair users;
- Ease congestion as a correctly aligned bus will not block the road for other road users;
- Ensure that bus drivers discharge their duty to drop passengers off on the kerb and not on the road;
- Ensure that bus services operate on time and are not unnecessarily delayed.

Any objections should clearly state the reasons for the objections and should reach us in writing, either by letter or email, by **23rd September 2025**. If the objection cannot be resolved, it will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time.
