STANDHILL ROAD/HIGHFIELD DRIVE, CARLTON – PROPOSED DOUBLE YELLOW LINES (NO WAITING AT ANY TIME) (TRO 7227) PUBLIC CONSULTATION

Via East Midlands Ltd, working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council, is proposing to introduce double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) at the junction of Highfield Drive and Standhill Road, Carlton. The restrictions are intended to replace the existing white line and "PATROL" markings at the junction of Highfield Drive and Standhill Road. The double yellow lines will help ensure that vehicles do not park in the vicinity of the junction. The removal of parked vehicles will give an unobstructed route for pedestrians, especially children attending the school on Standhill Road. Vehicles turning out of Highfield Drive will have a better view of traffic on Standhill Road.

The details of the proposals are shown on the enclosed plan and notice.
