

**NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
PROVISION OF TOUCAN CROSSING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to install a "Toucan" pedestrian crossing on Arnold Lane in the District of Gedling approximately 31 metres southeast of its junction with Shelford Road.

The crossing will incorporate a controlled area indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where parking and loading will be prohibited. The extents of the controlled area will be:

Arnold Lane

From a point approximately 8m northwest of the junction of Arnold Lane and Shelford Road for a distance of approximately 62m in a southeasterly direction.

The Toucan crossing will provide a safe crossing facility across Arnold Lane for pedestrians and cyclists.
