

NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 PROVISION OF TOUCAN CROSSING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to install a "Zebra" pedestrian crossing on Alfreton Road, Sutton in Ashfield in the District of Ashfield.

The crossing will incorporate a controlled area indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where parking and loading will be prohibited. The extents of the controlled area will be:

Alfreton Road (north-west side)

From a point approximately 10m south of the junction of Henning Lane for a distance of approximately 40m in a north-easterly direction.

<u>Alfreton Road (south-east side)</u>

From a point approximately 5m south of the junction of Henning Lane for a distance of approximately 25m in a north-easterly direction.

The Zebra crossing will provide a safe crossing facility across Alfreton Road for pedestrians.
