ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
PROVISION OF TOUCAN CROSSING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to install a “Zebra” pedestrian crossing on Alfreton Road, Sutton in Ashfield in the District of Ashfield.

The crossing will incorporate a controlled area indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where parking and loading will be prohibited. The extents of the controlled area will be:

Alfreton Road (north-west side)

From a point approximately 10m south of the junction of Henning Lane for a distance of approximately 40m in a north-easterly direction.

Alfreton Road (south-east side)

From a point approximately 5m south of the junction of Henning Lane for a distance of approximately 25m in a north-easterly direction.

The Zebra crossing will provide a safe crossing facility across Alfreton Road for pedestrians.
