**KEYWORTH ROAD, GEDLING – NO STOPPING ON SCHOOL ENTRANCE MARKINGS –
MONDAY – FRIDAY, 8AM TO 4.30PM – TRO 7218
PUBLIC CONSULTATION**

Via East Midlands Ltd, working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council, is proposing to introduce an additional “School Keep Clear” marking across the entrance to the Stanhope Primary and Nursery School. The school keep clear markings will ensure that the entrance to the school is kept clear of stopping vehicles to allow safe access to the main school reception and Jesters Club. This route avoids the steps on the main pedestrian entrance and will allow easier access for pushchair users and those with mobility aids. The no stopping restrictions will be in force on Monday to Friday between 8am and 4.30pm.

The new school keep clear marking will extend for 43.5 metres north-west from the end of the existing marking. The marking will be accompanied by 2 new additional signs.

Before proceeding further with the proposed no stopping on school entrance markings, I wish to consider the views of residents and organisations who may be interested in this matter. If your comments are in the form of an objection to the proposals and if they cannot be resolved, they will be reported through the County Council’s procedures at the appropriate time. Any observations on these proposals should reach me by **29th November 2019** in writing (address at bottom of letter) or by e-mail.
