

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Lincoln Road, Newark on Trent)(Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2018 (3281)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council, with the agreement of Nottingham City Council, proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in Newark on Trent in the District of Newark and Sherwood:-

Proposed **No waiting at any time** restrictions (double yellow lines) at the following locations:-

1. LINCOLN ROAD (NEWARK ON TRENT)

(the north-west side)

- (i) from a point 252 metres south-west of a point opposite the centre line of the junction with Emmendingen Avenue in a north-easterly direction to a point 91 metres north-east of the same point. (between 17 and 85 Lincoln Road)

The double yellow lines are being introduced to remove parked vehicles from the carriageway and footway. The footway is to be widened and made into a shared use foot/cycle path.
