

## The Nottinghamshire County Council Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

## <u>THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (LINCOLN ROAD, NEWARK ON TRENT)</u> (30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) RESTRICTED ROAD ORDER 2017 (3271)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be:-

1. The length of LINCOLN ROAD at Newark on Trent in the District of Newark and Sherwood specified below shall be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.

from its junction with North Gate in a north-easterly direction to point 30 metres south-west of its junction with The A1/A46 Roundabout.

Written objections (stating grounds and quoting ref: 3271) must be received by me by the **22nd day of December 2017**.

The 30mph speed limit is being introduced to replace the existing 40mph speed limit. The new speed limit would better reflect the built up nature of the road and would be in keeping with the side roads off Lincoln Road. The road is a mixture of residential and commercial properties with accesses directly off Lincoln Road. In addition to the new speed limit it is proposed to introduce an off-road cycle path along the north-west side of Lincoln Road.
