ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**PROVISION OF ZEBRA CROSSING**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to install a zebra pedestrian crossing across Lower Kirklington Road, Southwell in the District of Newark and Sherwood, approximately 14 metres north west of its junction with Burgage.

The crossing will incorporate a controlled area indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where parking and loading will be prohibited. The extents of the controlled area are: -

**Lower Kirklington Road– north east side**

From a point 7 metres south east of the centre line with its junction with Station Road, in a north westerly direction for a distance of 47 metres

**Lower Kirklington Road – south west side**

From a point 17 metres south east of the centre line of its junction with Burgage, in a north westerly direction for a distance of 51 metres.

The crossing is being installed to assist pedestrians crossing Lower Kirklington Road.
