

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL - MABEL GROVE, RADCLIFFE ROAD AND RUTLAND ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD - PROPOSED PARKING RESTRICTIONS (8403) - PROPOSED TOUCAN CROSSING - PROPOSED RAISED PLATEAUS - TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 90A - 90I of the Highways Act 1980 (traffic calming hump), Section 23, Section 9 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, proposes to install a toucan crossing on Radcliffe Road, West Bridgford in the Borough of Rushcliffe south-east of its junction with Rutland Road.

1. The extents of the raised plateaus are detailed below:

MABEL GROVE, WEST BRIDGFORD

• From its junction with Radcliffe Road, in a south-westerly direction for 15 metres.

RUTLAND ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD

- From its junction with Radcliffe Road, in a north-easterly direction for 19 metres.
- 2. The proposals will incorporate a controlled area, indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where **parking**, **stopping and loading will be prohibited**. The extents of the controlled areas are:-

RADCLIFFE ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD

(the north-east side)

• From a point 2 metres south-east of its junction with Rutland Road in a south-easterly direction for 45 metres.

(the south-west side)

- From a point opposite a point 2 metres south-west of its junction with Rutland Road in a south-easterly direction for 45 metres.
- 3. Proposed prohibition of Waiting At Any Time along the following lengths of road: -

MABEL GROVE, WEST BRIDGFORD

(the north-west side)

From a point 15 metres south-west of its junction with Radcliffe Road, in a south-westerly direction for 9 metres.

(the south-east side)

• From a point 15 metres south-west of its junction with Radcliffe Road, in a south-westerly direction for 4 metres.

RUTLAND ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD

(the north-west side)

• From its junction with Radcliffe Road, in a north-easterly direction for 19 metres.

(the south-east side)

• From its junction with Radcliffe Road, in a north-easterly direction for 27 metres.
