

## **PROVISION OF ZEBRA CROSSING**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes to install a zebra pedestrian crossing across Main Road, Jacksdale in the District of Ashfield approximately 67 metres north-west of its junction with Sedgewick Street.

The crossing will incorporate a controlled area indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where parking and loading will be prohibited. The extents of the controlled area are:-

### **Main Road, Jacksdale – south-west side**

from a point 48 metres north-west of a point opposite the north-western kerb line of Sedgewick Street in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 40 metres.

### **Main Road, Jacksdale – north-east side**

from a point 47 metres north-west of its junction with Sedgewick Street in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 40 metres.

The crossing is being installed to assist pedestrians, especially school children, in crossing the road.
