

PROVISION OF ZEBRA CROSSING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes to install a zebra pedestrian crossing across Main Road, Jacksdale in the District of Ashfield approximately 67 metres north-west of its junction with Sedgewick Street.

The crossing will incorporate a controlled area indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where parking and loading will be prohibited. The extents of the controlled area are:-

Main Road, Jacksdale - south-west side

from a point 48 metres north-west of a point opposite the north-western kerb line of Sedgewick Street in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 40 metres.

Main Road, Jacksdale - north-east side

from a point 47 metres north-west of its junction with Sedgewick Street in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 40 metres.

The crossing is being installed to assist pedestrians, especially school children, in crossing the road.
