## PROPOSED ZEBRA CROSSING ON MAIN ROAD, JACKSDALE - PUBLIC NOTIFICATION

Via East Midlands Ltd, working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council, is proposing to install a zebra crossing on Main Road, Jacksdale. The crossing will provide a safer crossing point for pedestrian crossing from the Medical Centre/car park to the shops on the opposite side. The exact location is shown on the attached drawing (H/JAB/2809/100) and notice. As part of the works the footway outside No.17 is proposed to be widened to 2.5 metres, this will give additional room for pedestrians to stand and wait to cross the road. The footway is also proposed to be widened outside the Medical Centre to enable pedestrians waiting at the crossing to be more visible to approaching vehicles and to reduce the distance pedestrians have to walk to cross the road.

On the north-eastern side of the road the zig-zag lines (no waiting and no loading at any time) will replace the existing single yellow line (no waiting on Monday to Saturday between 8am and 6.30pm). On the opposite side of the road the existing bus stop clearway (no stopping except buses at any time) will be reduced in length to accommodate the new zig-zag lines. The existing dropped kerbs will be retained to allow access to existing driveways.

Before proceeding further, I wish to consider the views of residents, businesses and organisations who may be interested in this matter. If your comments are in the form of an objection to the proposals and if they cannot be resolved, they will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time. Any observations on these proposals should reach me in writing, either by letter (address at bottom of letter) or email, by **30**th **August 2019**.
