MAIN ROAD – RADCLIFFE ON TRENT
PROVISION OF ZEBRA CROSSING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to install a Zebra pedestrian crossing Main Road, Radcliffe-on-Trent, in the District of Rushcliffe approximately 15 metres west of its junction with New Road. The crossing will incorporate a controlled area indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where parking and loading will be prohibited. The extents of the controlled area are:-

Main Road

from a point 5 metres west of its junction with New Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 25 metres.

CONSTRUCTION OF ROAD HUMP 2017/18

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of powers conferred by Section 90A - 90I of the Highways Act 1980 propose to “Traffic Calm” part of Main Road, Radcliffe on Trent.

The effects of which will be:-

A single 75mm high, 14m long (including approach ramps), flat-topped road hump (plateau) constructed on Main Road approximately 9 metres west of the junction with New Road.
