

PROVISION OF HUMPED ZEBRA CROSSING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (Zebra crossing) and Section 90A - 90I of the Highways Act 1980 (traffic calming hump), proposes to install a humped zebra pedestrian crossing across Main Street, Calverton in the Borough of Gedling approximately 32 metres south-east of its junction with Renals Way

The crossing will incorporate a controlled area indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where parking and loading will be prohibited. The extents of the controlled area are:-

Main Street – north-west side

from a point 28 metres south-east of its junction with Renals Way in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 18 metres.

Main Street – south-east side

from a point 37 metres south-east of its junction with Renals Way in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 18 metres.

The crossing will be constructed on a road hump, the effects of which will be:-

A single 75mm high, 11.5m long (including approach ramps), flat-topped road hump (plateau) constructed on Main Road (starting) approximately 28 metres south-east of the junction with Renals Way.

The crossing is being installed to assist pedestrians crossing Main Street including: parents and children traveling to or from the local primary school; pedestrians using the nearby shopping precinct or car park and users of Calverton Library.

Any comments/objections (quoting ref: Main Street, Calverton – Zebra Crossing) in respect of the zebra crossing or the traffic calming proposal must be received by me, in writing, by **9th August 2019**.
