

**NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**PROVISION OF ZEBRA CROSSING**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to install a zebra pedestrian crossing across Main Street, Calverton in the Borough of Gedling approximately 37 metres south east of the centre line of its junction with Renals Way.

The crossing will incorporate a controlled area indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where parking and loading will be prohibited. The extents of the controlled area are:-

**Main Street – north-east side**

from a point 16 metres south east of the centre line of its junction with Renals Way in a South-easterly direction for a distance of 40 metres.

**Main Street – south-west side**

from a point 16 metres south east of the centre line of its junction with Renals Way in a South-easterly direction for a distance of 40 metres.

The crossing is being installed to assist pedestrians, especially school children and shoppers, in crossing Main Street.
