**LINGWOOD LANE AND MAIN STREET, WOODBOROUGH  
PROPOSED PARKING RESTRICTIONS - PUBLIC CONSULTATION – TRO 7258**

Via East Midlands Ltd, working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council, is proposing to introduce double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) and single yellow lines (no waiting Monday to Friday between 8am and 4.30pm) on Lingwood Lane and Main Street in Woodborough. The restrictions on Lingwood Lane are intended to help ensure that the local bus is not obstructed by inconsiderate parking, especially at the busy times at the beginning and end of the school day. The proposals at the junction with Main Street are intended to keep the road clear of parked vehicles to give turning vehicles a clearer view and give an unobstructed route for pedestrians who are crossing the road.

On the eastern side of Lingwood Lane the restrictions would extend from the junction with Main Street to a point south of the Village Hall. At the junction the proposed restrictions would be double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) and single yellow lines and existing school keep clear markings (in force on Monday to Friday between 8am to 4.30pm) would cover the road outside the school and Village Hall. On the western side of Lingwood Lane the proposed double yellow lines would be at the narrow part of the road outside No.8 and at the junction with Main Street and opposite the church.

The positions of the new restrictions are shown on the attached plan and notice.

Before proceeding further with the proposed parking restrictions, I wish to consider the views of residents and organisations who may be interested in this matter. If your comments are in the form of an objection to the proposals and if they cannot be resolved, they will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time. Any observations on these proposals should reach me by **25<sup>th</sup> November 2022**. All comments/objections should be sent to either the e-mail address or postal address below.
