

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Lingwood Lane and Main Street, Woodborough) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2022 (7258)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in Woodborough in the Borough of Gedling:-

1. Proposed **No waiting at any time** restrictions (double yellow lines) at the following locations in Woodborough:-

(i) LINGWOOD LANE (the east side)

from its junction with Main Street in a southerly direction for a distance of 15 metres.

LINGWOOD LANE (the west side)

- (ii) from its junction with Main Street in a southerly direction for a distance of 47 metres.
- (iii) from a point 68 metres south of its junction with Main Street in a southerly direction for a distance of 25 metres.

MAIN STREET (the south side)

- (iv) from a point 10 metres west of its junction with Lingwood Lane in an easterly direction to a point 10 metres east of the same junction.
- <u>2. Proposed No waiting on Mon Fri, 8am to 4.30pm restrictions (single yellow lines) at the following locations in Woodborough:</u>

LINGWOOD LANE (the east side)

- (i) from a point 15 metres south of its junction with Main Street in a southerly direction to a point 6 metres south of the property boundary between Eriskay and Maydon.
- (ii) from a point 50 metres south of the property boundary between Eriskay and Maydon in a southerly direction to a point 17 metres north of the access to the Village Hall car park.
- (iii) from a point 20 metres south-west of its junction with the access to the Village Hall car park in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 20 metres.

The parking restrictions are being proposed to remove parked vehicles from Lingwood Lane to help ensure that the local bus is not obstructed by inconsiderately parked vehicles, especially during the busy beginning and end of the school day. The restrictions at the junction with Main Street will help give better visibility for vehicles turning in and out of Lingwood Lane and keep the junction clear for pedestrians to cross the road.
