

## The Nottinghamshire County Council (Various Sites in Mansfield Woodhouse) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2018 (2211)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be on the following roads in Mansfield Woodhouse in the District of Mansfield: -

1. to prohibit waiting at any time at the following locations,

<u>Albion Street:</u> - From its junction with Chesterfield Road South in a south westerly direction for a distance of 32 metres on its north west side

<u>Albion Street:</u> - From its junction with Chesterfield Road South in a south westerly direction for a distance of 32 metres on its south east side

<u>Beech Tree Avenue</u>: - From the perimeter of the roundabout in a northerly direction on both sides for 23 metres

Brown Avenue:- From the perimeter of the roundabout in a south westerly direction on both sides for 10 metres

<u>Coxs Lane:-</u> From the perimeter of the roundabout in a north westerly direction for 30 metres on its south west side

<u>Coxs Lane:</u> From the perimeter of the roundabout in a north westerly direction for 37 metres on its north west side

<u>Crow Hill Lane</u>: - From its junction with Mansfield Road in a south westerly direction for a distance of 21 metres on both sides

<u>Edgehill Grove</u>: - From its junction with Leeming Lane South in a north westerly direction for a distance of 10 metres on both sides

<u>King Street</u>: - From its junction with Leeming Lane South in a south easterly direction for a distance of 18 metres on both sides

<u>Kingsley Avenue:</u> - From a point 12 metres west of its junction with Ley Lane in an easterly direction to a point 34 metres east of that junction on its southern side

<u>Kingsley Avenue:</u> - From a point 33 metres west of its junction with Manor Park Sports in an easterly direction to a point 14 metres east of that junction on its northern side

<u>Ley Lane: - From its junction with Kingsley Avenue in a southerly direction on both sides</u> for a distance of 11 metres

<u>Mansfield Road:</u> -From a point 14 metres north of its junction with Tennyson Avenue in a southerly direction to a point 18 metres south of that junction on its eastern side

Mansfield Road: -From a point 11 metres north of its junction with Crow Hill Lane in a southerly direction to a point 13 metres south of that junction on its western side

<u>Park Avenue</u>:- From the perimeter of the roundabout in a south easterly direction on both sides for 11 metres

<u>Park Hall Road</u>: -\_From a point 13 metres north west of its junction with Worcester Avenue on its north eastern side in a south easterly direction to a point 42 metres south east of that junction

<u>Park Hall Road</u>: - From a point 50 metres north west of its junction with Sycamore Road on its south western side in a south easterly direction to a point 10 metres south east of that junction

<u>Slant Lane: -</u> From the perimeter of the roundabout in a south easterly direction for 9 metres on its south eastern side

<u>Slant Lane: -</u> From the perimeter of the roundabout in a south easterly direction for a distance of 12 metres on its south western side

<u>Springwood Drive: -</u> From its junction with Leeming Lane South in a north westerly direction for a distance of 10 metres on both sides

<u>Sycamore Road:</u> - From its junction with Park Hall Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 8 metres on both sides

<u>Tennyson Avenue</u>: - From its junction with Mansfield Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 10 metres on both sides

Welbeck Road: - From a point 20 metres north east of its junction with Church Hillin a north easterly direction for a distance of 34 metres on its north east side

Worcester Avenue:- From its junction with Park Hall Road in a north easterly direction for a distance of 9 metres on both sides
