**(30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) RESTRICTED ROAD ORDER 2018 (7199)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be:-

1. The length of A60 Mansfield Road at Arnold in the Borough of Gedling specified below shall be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.

from a point 60 metres north of the centre point of the traffic island at its junction with Cross Street in a northerly direction for a distance of 100 metres.

Written objections (stating grounds and quoting ref: 7199) must be received by me by the **12th day of November 2018**.

The 30mph speed limit is being introduced to replace the existing 40mph speed limit. The new speed limit would start from a point further in advance of the traffic signals at the junction of A60 Mansfield Road and Cross Street, this would help to slow traffic as it approaches the signals. The aim of the scheme is to reduce the number of vehicles mistakenly driving through the signals when they are at red.
