

**The Nottinghamshire County Council (Langtry Gardens, Market Place and Station Street, Bingham)(20M.P.H. Speed Limit) Order (8333) and (Market Place, Bingham)(One Way Street and Prohibition of Entry)Traffic Regulation Order 2021 (8334)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in Bingham in the Borough of Rushcliffe:-

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding **20 miles per hour** at the following locations:-
  - (i) LANGTRY GARDENS  
from its junction with Station Street in an easterly direction to its north-eastern and south-eastern extremities.
  - (ii) MARKET PLACE  
from its junction with Market Street in an easterly and then a southerly direction to its junction with Church Street.
  - (iii) STATION STREET  
from its junction with Market Place in a northerly direction to its northern extremity.
  
2. The effects of the Order (**One-way**) will apply to the following road:-
  - (i) MARKET PLACE  
from its junction with Market Street in an easterly and then a southerly direction to its junction with Church Street.
  
3. The effects of the Order (**Prohibition of Entry**) will apply to following road:-
  - (i) MARKET PLACE  
No entry into Market Place from Church Street

The new 20mph speed limit will help reduce the speed of traffic and ensure a safer environment for pedestrians and cyclists especially around the busy Market Place. The one way will allow the traffic around the narrow Market Place to flow more freely as traffic will not have to give way to vehicles travelling in the opposite direction.

Written objections (stating grounds and quoting ref. 8333 (for speed limit) or 8334 (for one way and No entry)) must be received by me by the **22nd November 2021**.

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
