Via East Midlands Ltd, working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council, is proposing to introduce double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) to the junctions of Mile End Road with Colwick Manor Farm, Crosslands Meadow and Ramblers Close. The proposed double yellow lines are being introduced to remove parked vehicles from the 3 junctions. The proposed restrictions will give better visibility for vehicles turning into or out of the junctions and will also give an unobstructed route for pedestrians to cross the road.
