

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (MILL LANE, KIRKBY IN ASHFIELD) (30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2025 (4316)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Kirkby in Ashfield in the Ashfield District in the County of Nottinghamshire.

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on that length of road specified in the Schedule of this Order.

SCHEDULE

MILL LANE, KIRKBY IN ASHFIELD

• From a point 6 metres south of its junction with Laburnum Avenue in a south-easterly direction for 69 metres.
