

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Newark and Sherwood Area)(Prohibition of Driving) Traffic Regulation Order (3286)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effects of which will be to roads and byways in the Newark and Sherwood Area of Nottinghamshire:-

1. The following list of **byways** are to be **closed** to all motorised traffic (except solo motor cycles) and horse drawn vehicles between **1st November** and **30th April**.
 - (i) Farnsfield Byway No.33 (Rob Lane) and Edingley Byway No.21 (Rob Lane) (Farnsfield and Edingley)
 - (ii) Kersall Byway No. 8 (Mill Lane) (Kersall)

The closure is to be introduced during the winter months when the weather makes the surface of the byway wet and muddy. The proposed restriction will prevent the use of the byway by motorised vehicles (except solo motor cycles) and horse drawn vehicles. Closing the byway during the winter months will reduce the damage to the surface of the byway making it safer for all other users. The proposed byways have been identified as being damaged by the overuse of motorised vehicles.

Written objections (stating grounds and quoting ref. 3286) must be received by me by the **7th day of December 2018**.
