

**NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984  
PROVISION OF TOUCAN CROSSING**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to install a “Toucan” pedestrian crossing on Nottingham Road, Giltbrook in the District of Broxtowe approximately 16 metres north of the existing roundabout where Gilt Hill and Ikea Way cross.

The crossing will incorporate a controlled area indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where parking and loading will be prohibited. The extents of the controlled area will be:

**Nottingham Road**

From a point approximately 7m north of the roundabout of Nottm Rd and Gilt Hill for a distance of approximately 23m in a northerly direction on the southbound approach.

From a point approximately 2m north of the roundabout of Nottm Rd and Gilt Hill for a distance of approximately 18m in a northerly direction on the northbound approach.

The Toucan crossing will provide a safe crossing facility across Nottingham Road for pedestrians and cyclists.
