**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A60 NOTTINGHAM ROAD, HARLOW
WOOD, MANSFIELD) (40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2017 (4199)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to roads in Harlow Wood in the District of Mansfield:-

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the following length of road,

A60 Nottingham Road from a point 52 metres south of the centre line of Lichfield Lane, Mansfield in a southerly direction to a point 522 metres south of the centre line of the Portland College access road.

2. The effects of the following Order (insofar as it relates to the speed limit(s) on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order) are hereby revoked:-
 - (a) The 70 miles per hour, 60 miles per hour and 50 miles per hour (Temporary Speed Limit) (Continuation) Order 1978
