CONSTRUCTION OF ROAD HUMP 2017/18

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of powers conferred by Section 90A - 90I of the Highways Act 1980 propose to "Traffic Calm" part of Humber Road South, Beeston

The effects of which will be:-

A single 75mm high, 5m long (including approach ramps), flat-topped road hump (plateau) constructed on Humber Road South approximately 7 metres southwest of the junction with Beacon Road.
