

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(STAPLE LANE, BALDERTON) (PROHIBITION OF
DRIVING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025 (3396)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended; the effect of which will be, in relation to Staple Lane, Balderton in the District of Newark and Sherwood: -

1. **To prohibit vehicles other than pedal cycles from driving on**

Staple Lane, Balderton

From its junction with Staple Lane (Link Road) in a northerly then north-easterly direction for 62 metres.
