

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Padge Road, Beeston) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2018 (5254)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Beeston in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting At Any Time along: -

PADGE ROAD, BEESTON (the north-west side)

From its junction with Beacon Road in an easterly then north-easterly direction for 188 metres

From a point 220 metres north-east of its junction with Beacon Road in a north-easterly direction for 24 metres

From a point 256 metres north-east of its junction with Beacon Road in a north-easterly direction for 29 metres

From a point 303 metres north-east of its of junction with Beacon Road in a north-easterly direction for 44 metres

PADGE ROAD, BEESTON (the south-east side)

From a point 95 metres north-east of its junction with Beacon Road in a north-easterly direction for 257 metres
