PARK ROAD, BESTWOOD VILLAGE PROPOSED DOUBLE YELLOW LINES (NO WAITING AT ANY TIME) AND CLEARWAY FOR BUS STAND (NO STOPPING AT ANY TIME, EXCEPT BUSES) – TRO 7245

Via East Midlands Ltd, working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council, is proposing to introduce double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) and an extended bus stand (no stopping at any time, except buses) on Park Road and in the bus turning area.

The proposed double yellow lines are intended to remove parked vehicles from the area around the bus turning area on Park Road. The lines will help ensure that the bus can turn around and can stop adjacent to the kerbs to drop off and pick up passengers. In addition the restrictions will keep the bend clear and give vehicles pulling out of the Bestwood Country Park car park a clearer view along the road.

Before proceeding further with the proposed double yellow lines and bus stand clearway, I wish to consider the views of residents and organisations who may be interested in this matter. If your comments are in the form of an objection to the proposals and if they cannot be resolved, they will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time.
