

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A616, OLLERTON ROAD, LITTLE CARLTON AND SOUTH MUSKHAM) 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT ORDER 2022 (3351)

The Council of the County of Nottinghamshire ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order: -

- 1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule of this Order.
- The following Order shall be revoked in as far as it relates to the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this order
 The Nottinghamshire County Council (Little Carlton and South Muskham. A616, B6325 Church Lane and Crow Lane) (30 mph and 50 mph Speed Limit) (3256) Order 2017
- 3. Any previous speed limit order made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or any enactment replace by that Act in so far as it relates to the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order is hereby revoked.
- 4. This Order may be cited as "The Nottinghamshire County Council (A616, Ollerton Road, Little Carlton, Newark) 40 Mph Speed Limit Order 2022 (3351)"

Length of the A616 at Little Carlton, in the District of Newark and Sherwood

A616 Ollerton Road

From a point 20 metres south-east of its junction with Ollerton Road (Western Arm) to a point 25 metres west of its roundabout junction with B6325 Great North Road
