

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (KNEESALL ROAD,
MOORHOUSE ROAD AND THE BAR, LAXTON)
(30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2022 (3348)**

The Council of the County of Nottinghamshire ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order: -

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule of this Order.
2. This Order may be cited as THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (KNEESALL ROAD, MOORHOUSE ROAD AND THE BAR, LAXTON) (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2022 (3348) and shall come into force on xx XXXXXX 2022.
3. Any previous speed limit order made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or any enactment replaced by that Act in so far as it related to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE

Lengths of roads at Laxton in the District of Newark and Sherwood
to become (30 miles per hour):

KNEESALL ROAD, LAXTON

From a point 34 metres south-west of the property boundary between Corner Cottage and Kneesall Cottage, Laxton in a southerly direction for 35 metres.

MOORHOUSE ROAD, LAXTON

From a point 425 metres south-east of its junction with Main Street, Laxton in a south-easterly direction for 35 metres.

THE BAR, LAXTON

From a point 78 metres north-east of its junction with Crosshill, Laxton in a north-easterly direction for 53 metres as measured along the north-western kerb line.
