

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (KNEESALL ROAD,  
MOORHOUSE ROAD AND THE BAR, LAXTON)  
(30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2022 (3348)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads in Laxton in the District of Newark and Sherwood: -

No person shall drive any vehicle at a **speed exceeding 30 miles** per hour along the following lengths of road: -

**KNEESALL ROAD, LAXTON**

From a point 34 metres south-west of the property boundary between Corner Cottage and Kneesall Cottage, Laxton in a southerly direction for 35 metres.

**MOORHOUSE ROAD, LAXTON**

From a point 425 metres south-east of its junction with Main Street, Laxton in a south-easterly direction for 35 metres.

**THE BAR, LAXTON**

From a point 78 metres north-east of its junction with Crosshill, Laxton in a north-easterly direction for 53 metres as measured along the north-western kerb line.
