**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A6075 BECK LANE,
SUTTON IN ASHFIELD) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2022 (4728)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an order under the road traffic regulation act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads in Sutton in Ashfield in the District of Ashfield.

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on: -

A6075 Beck Lane, Sutton in Ashfield

- From a point 135 metres north-east of its junction with Mansfield Road, Sutton in Ashfield in a north-easterly direction for 406 metres.
