Via East Midlands Ltd, working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council, is proposing to introduce additional double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) on Mount Pleasant. The extra lines would extend north from the boundary of No. 27 for approximately 11 metres (see enclosed plan). The scheme was previously advertised in December 2021.
