

The Nottinghamshire County Council
(Farndon Road and The Osiers, Newark) (Prohibition of Waiting)
Traffic Regulation Order 2018 (3288)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads, in the District of Newark And Sherwood: -

Vehicles will be prohibited from **waiting at any time** along the following lengths of road: -

FARNDON ROAD, NEWARK

(western side)

- From a point 20 metres north east of its junction with The Osiers in a south westerly to a point direction for 22 metres of that junction.

THE OSIERS, NEWARK

(north eastern side)

- From its junction with Farndon Road in a north westerly direction for 16 metres.

THE OSIERS, NEWARK

(south western side)

- From its junction with Farndon Road in a north westerly direction for 18 metres.
- From a point 45 metres north west of its junction with Farndon Road in a north westerly direction for 22 metres.
